

ICAR-NRC on Pig, Rani organized Awareness Camp cum Input Distribution Program at Singimari Village of Khandajan Post Office of Darrang District in Assam under SCSP

An Awareness Camp cum Input Distribution Program was successfully organized by the ICAR–National Research Centre on Pig, Rani under the Scheduled Caste Sub Plan (SCSP) on 10th October, 2025, at Singimari Village, under Khandajan Post Office, Darrang District, Assam. A total of 141 Scheduled Caste beneficiaries actively participated in the program. The event commenced with a brief introductory session by Dr. Jayachitra Devi, Scientist, who highlighted the objectives of the SCSP scheme and elaborated on the institute’s continuous efforts towards improving the livelihood of marginalized pig-rearing communities through scientific pig production and input support. During the awareness session, Dr. Priyajoy Kar, Scientist, delivered a lecture on pig marketing, demand and supply trends, Government initiatives, and credit assistance opportunities for pig farming, which was well appreciated by the participants. Dr. Kalyan De, Senior Scientist, interacted with the farmers and discussed various practical aspects of scientific pig farming, including breed selection, housing, feeding, and management practices for enhanced productivity and profitability. Following the technical session, input distribution was conducted wherein a total of 14.5 tonnes (290 bags x 50 kg) of pig feed and 140 umbrellas were distributed among the 141 Scheduled Caste farmers. The participants expressed their gratitude towards ICAR–NRC on Pig for organizing the event and appreciated the institute’s initiatives in enhancing their knowledge and providing valuable input support for sustainable pig farming.
