ICAR-NRC on Pig, Rani organized Farmers Field Day and Input Distribution Program at Chirang District in Assam under SCSP

A Farmers Field Day cum Input Distribution Program was successfully organized by the ICAR-National Research Centre on Pig, Rani under the Scheduled Caste Sub Plan (SCSP) on 31st July, 2025, at Sundri Village, Sidli Block, Chirang District, Assam. In this program, a total of 210 Scheduled Caste beneficiaries participated. The event was started by Dr. Jayachitra Devi, Scientist; with a brief introduction about the program; the objectives of the SCSP scheme, along with the ongoing efforts of ICAR-NRC on Pig to uplift marginalized pig-rearing communities through scientific interventions and input support. During the interaction session with the farmers, Dr. Satish Kumar, Scientist and Dr. Kalyan De, Sr. Scientist; described the different practical aspects of breed selection, housing and management for improving pig husbandry and scientific pig farming. Following the awareness session, input distribution was carried out with the distribution of 21 tonnes (420 bags x 50 kg) of pig feed and 200 LED emergency lights. The participants appreciated and thanked the efforts of ICAR-NRC on pig for improving their knowledge in pig farming and receiving the inputs.
