Institute at a Glance

With a glorious history of 137 years, ICAR-Indian Veterinary Research Institute (Deemed University), Izatnagar (UP) is one of the oldest premier national institutions in Veterinary and Animal Sciences in the world. The ICAR-IVRI has also been actively involved in teaching and training veterinary professionals since the dawn of 20th century. Regular post-graduate and refresher courses were organized since 1922 and the institute started awarding Diploma for the Associateship of IVRI in 1943 and a P.G. College of Animal Sciences was established in 1958. In the beginning, it was affiliated to the Agra University and subsequently to Rohilkhand University. The Deemed University status was conferred by UGC in 1983. The IVRI-Deemed University with its reputation for quality education offers Master's degree in 22 disciplines and Doctoral degree in 19 disciplines. The under graduate degree programme (BVSc & AH) has also been initiated from 2015 with an intake of 20. The institute is under the Department of Agriculture, Research and Education, Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare, Government of India. Presently the institute is imparting UG (BVSc & AH) & PG Education in various disciplines of Veterinary & Animal Sciences (MVSc-19, PhD-17 disciplines).

Capacity Building of Stakeholders

The diploma will help to build confidence in the capabilities of the professionals. Various aspects of animal production, reproduction, health care, welfare, nutrition, value-added milk and meat products, wild-life management, clinical diagnostic techniques, surgical interventions, organic livestock production, vaccinology, radiology, entrepreneurship development, preventive veterinary medicine; etc will be covered in various Diploma Courses. It will develop skills to apply appropriate strategies for the overall development of the livestock industry/sector under field and farm conditions.

Assessment Criteria

The assessments will focus on the application of knowledge gained in solving case studies. For each exam the qualification requires a minimum of 50% marks upon which the Diploma certificate shall be provided to the candidate.

Guidelines/Instructions to the Candidates

Application Fee:

1. Application fee for PG Diploma is Rs.500/- for General & OBC Candidates and Rs.250 for SC/ ST/PH/ EWS category candidates.
2. **Application Fee is to be deposited online. For online fee the applicant has to visit IVRI Website (www.ivri.nic.in) and click on Students Corner and then click Fee.** Candidate can also directly go the site <https://www.onlinesbi.com/sbicollect/icollecthome.htm> for payment of the fee. *No cash or demand draft on account of fee will be accepted.*
3. Candidates can opt for only one diploma course in a particular year based on the eligibility and availability of seats they can choose any one of the programme.
4. The minimum qualification for admission in the diploma course is Bachelor of Veterinary Sciences and Animal Husbandry from any of the VCI recognized college/University.
5. The interested candidates are advised to apply in the prescribed application form for admission alongwith all the self attested testimonials on email ivri.diplomacertificate2023@gmail.com on or before the last date. The last date of applications for PG Diploma courses is **30th June, 2026.**
6. Central/ State Government Departments or NGO may also depute their candidates for any of the above courses.
7. In addition to the above diploma courses customized diploma programme may also be arranged for the groups of the candidates on the requests of the sponsoring agencies and with due permission from the competent authority.
8. The Information Brochure and Admission form are available on the Institute's website (www.ivri.nic.in). The applicants selected for admission will be allowed to join the respective course as per above schedule. The exact schedule and Calendar will be uploaded on the Institute's website in due course of time.
9. The final list of the selected candidates for PG Diploma Course will be displayed at IVRI website. The selected candidates for admission will have to deposit the prescribed course fee as per schedule date intimated to them before joining the course.
10. The sponsored candidates are advised to submit the No Objection Certificate (NOC) and reliving order form the sponsoring agency at the time of the physical reporting/admission failing which admission to diploma course may be cancelled.
11. The payment of fees as per the prescribed term calendar is mandatory for each semester. Failure to comply with the fee submission schedule may result in cancellation of admission.

Additional guidelines/instructions for Online/hybrid PG diploma courses:

12. For the online/hybrid PG diploma courses 10 days mandatory practical exposure physically per semester is compulsory .
13. The candidates registered/admitted in diploma courses through online/hybrid mode have to submit the prescribed fees for particular diploma course (Rs 10,000 per semester).
14. The candidates joining institute physically for practical classes/examinations have to arrange boarding and lodging for entire period of stay at their own.
15. Minimum 75% of the attendance in diploma courses through online/hybrid and offline mode will be mandatory for the candidates registered in the diploma course.
16. Every candidate must arrange a laptop or phone device along with good internet connectivity to attend the online lectures.

Guidelines for Examination and Evaluation of PG diploma students for the physical & online/hybrid courses

1. PG diploma students may be evaluated on performance indicators viz. Quiz (10 marks), Midterm (30 marks), assignments (10 marks) or oral examination (10 marks) and final examinations (50 marks) online using Google forms or other available electronic tools or offline.
2. Each course offered will be of 100 marks and distributed as Quiz (10 marks), Mid-Term (30 marks), Assignment (10 marks) and final examination (50 marks).
3. If the course have theory and practical portion in the same course (like 1+1 or 2+1, 3+1 etc). The marks distribution will be 100 marks for theory and 100 marks for practical (Total 100 marks) and will be break as Quiz (10 marks), Mid-term (30 marks), Assignment (10 marks) and final examination (50 Marks) for theory portion and Practical Quiz (10 marks), Practical Mid-term (30 marks), Viva voce/oral examination (10 marks) and final practical examination. The weightage will be 50% (i.e. 100 marks)
4. The exam pattern has to be followed for each courses offered in either of the semester.
5. The online oral evaluation for practical courses may be conducted by the three members committee (preferably involved in teaching the diploma courses) under the Chairmanship of Head of the Division/Joint Director of the campus or his nominee. The three faculty members may be constituted by the Head of the division/ Joint Director, one of which must include the course instructor. The overall evaluation of the students will be done based on available grading system of the university.

6. Any one exam either midterm or final examinations may be conducted in offline mode during their mandatory visit to the respective institute.
7. Time schedule for the examination either offline or online may be shared with students and university well in advance.
8. 75% attendance in each course either theory or practical is mandatory to appear in the final examinations. The course coordinators may have the vigil on the attendance & long time absentees may be warned accordingly.
9. The minimum passing mark in each course is 50%.
10. University academic rules and regulations will be followed for the PG Diploma Courses.
