How to reach

ICAR- NRCP, Rani is located approximately 11 km from Guwahati Airport, 25 km from Kamakhya Railway Station, 30 km from Paltan Bazar Railway Station, 28 km from ISBT Guwahati, and 21 km from Adabari Bus Stand.

City bus services are available up to Azara/Rani Gate. Participants may hire a taxi at their own cost from these points to reach ICAR- NRCP, Rani. Local conveyance is also available from Rani Gate to the Institute.

How to apply

The application is open to aspiring and existing entrepreneurs and farmers. This is a self-sponsored 3-day residential training programme. The application fee for the programme is Rs. 4,000/- (excluding food and accommodation).

Accommodation and food are available at the institute's guest house/canteen on a payment basis.
