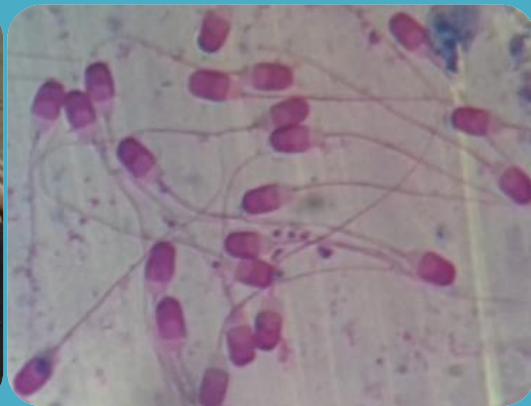

The institute conducts regular trainings, capacity building and outreach programmes for the benefit of students, entrepreneurs, field functionaries, veterinary officers, extension workers and farmers.

How to Apply

The application is open to aspiring and existing farmers and entrepreneurs belonging to scheduled tribe communities. Interested farmers belonging to scheduled tribal social caste category can participate in the training programme free of cost. Details required in the application form may be send to aitrainingnrcp@gmail.com before 25th July 2026. The application should accompany caste certificate to prove the scheduled tribe status of the applicants. Admission to the training programme will be done on first come first served basis. The Tribal Sub Plan of the institute sponsors the food and accommodation during the 3 days of the training programme. Accommodation on shared basis (3-4 beds/room) will be arranged at the Anubrata Bhawan during the training period. Transportation and local conveyance have to be arranged by the participants. Selected applicants will be informed through phone call on the number /email given in the application form. Applicants should report on 27th July 2026 (9am) at ICAR-NRC on Pig.

ICAR-National Research Centre on Pig, Rani, Guwahati is located at a distance of 11 Km from Guwahati Airport, 25 Km from Kamakhya Railway station, 30 Km from Paltan Bazar Railway station, 28 Km from ISBT, Guwahati and 21 Km from Adabari Bus Stand, Guwahati.
