# How to reach

ICAR-National Research Centre on Pig Guwahati is located at a distance of 11 Km from Guwahati Airport, 25 Km from Kamakhya Railway station, 30 Km from Paltan Bazar Railway station, 28 Km from ISBT, Guwahati and 21 Km from Adabari Bus Stand, Guwahati. Participants may hire taxi at their own cost from these points to reach ICAR-NRC on Pig, Rani. Local conveyance is also available from Rani Gate to reach the Institute.

# Details

## Eligibility

The application is open to aspiring and existing farmers and entrepreneurs belonging to scheduled tribe communities. The Tribal Sub Plan of the institute sponsors the food and accommodation during the 3 days of the training programme.. Accommodation on shared basis (3-4 beds/room) will be arranged at the farmers hostel during the training period. Transportation and local conveyance have to be arranged by the participants.
