How to reach

ICAR-National Research Centre on Pig Guwahati is located at a distance of 11 Km from Guwahati Airport, 25 Km from Kamakhya Railway station, 30 Km from Paltan Bazar Railway station, 28 Km from ISBT, Guwahati and 21 Km from Adabari Bus Stand, Guwahati. Participants may hire taxi at their own cost from these points to reach ICAR-NRC on Pig, Rani. Local conveyance is also available from Rani Gate to reach the Institute.

The application is open to aspiring and existing farmers and entrepreneurs. Application fee for the programme is Rs 4000/- (excluding food and accommodation).
